A thin smile crossed the rubber faces of the children.

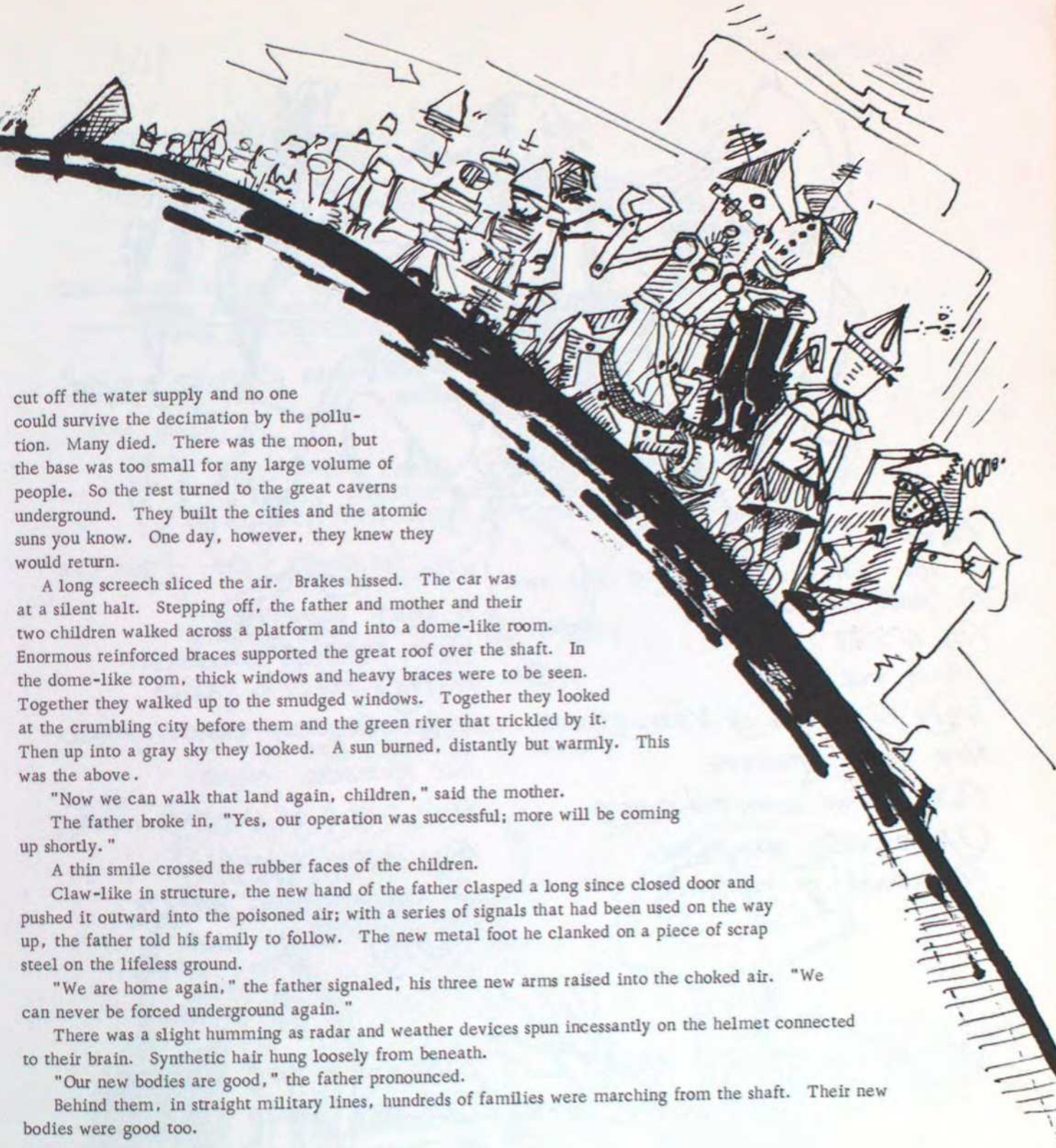
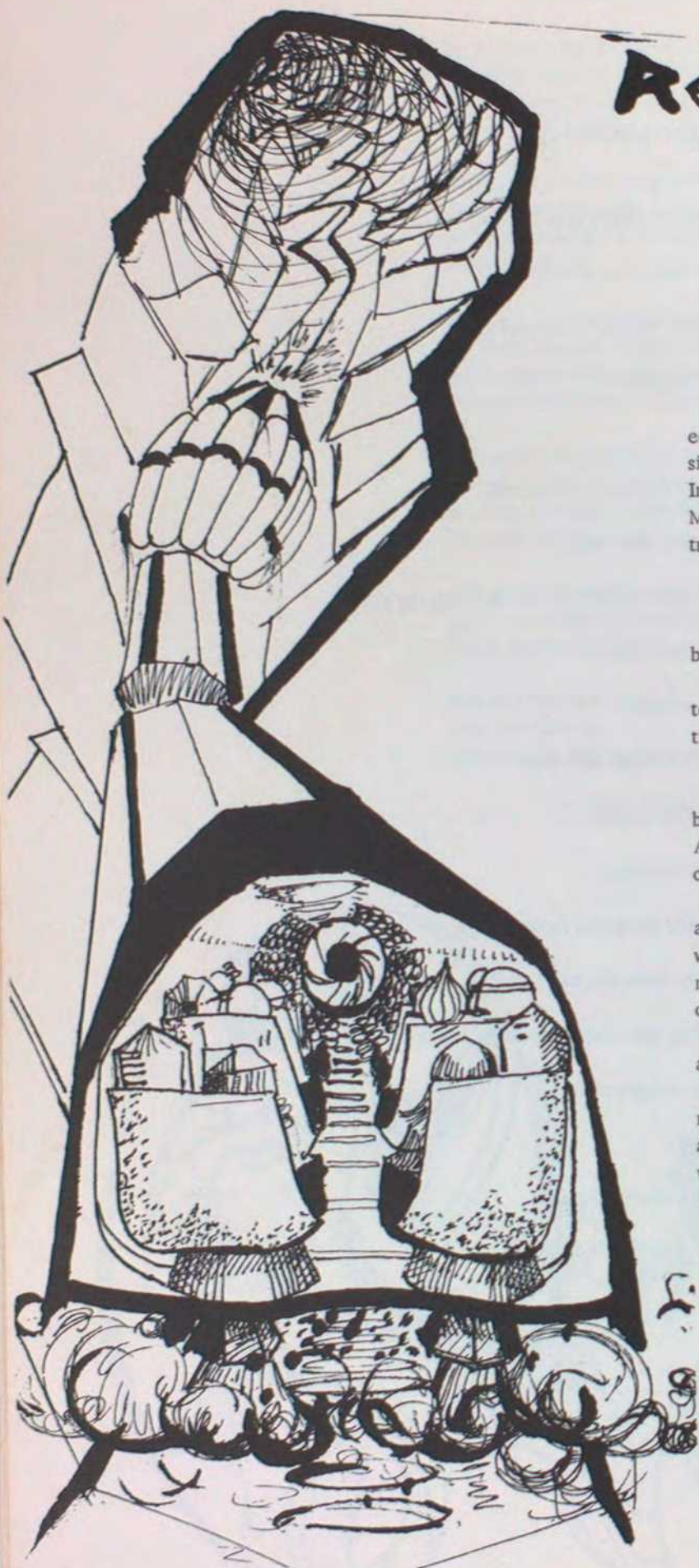

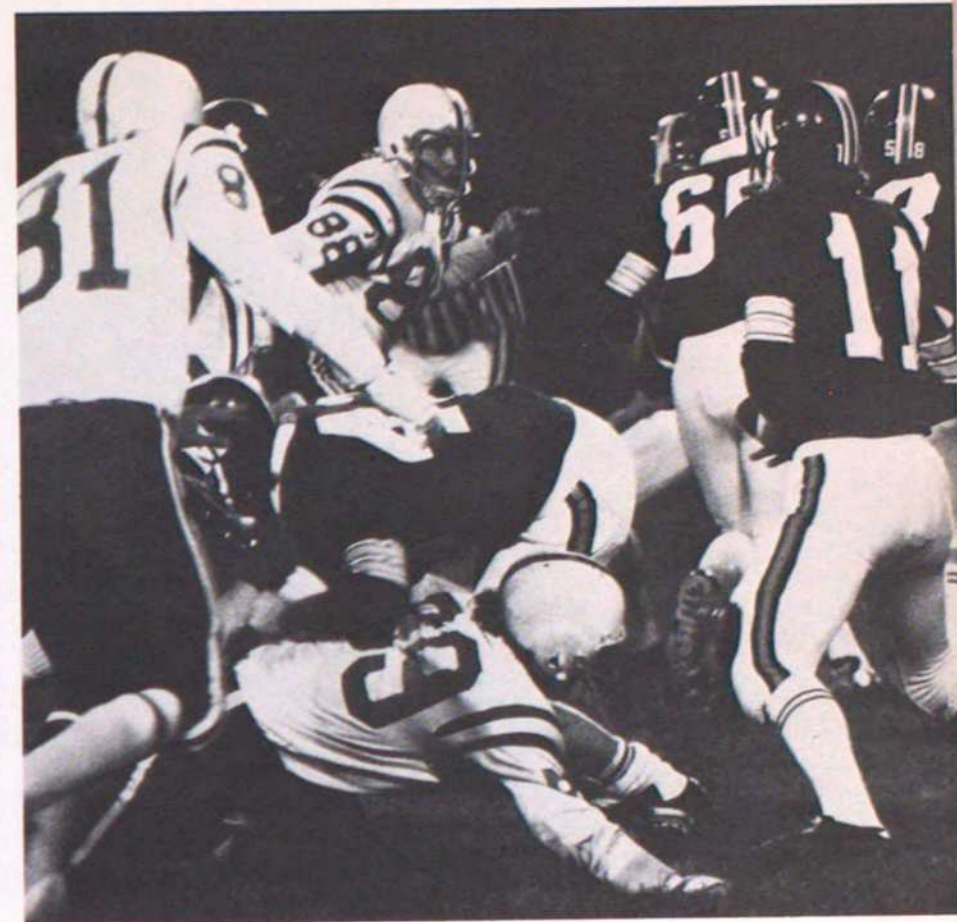
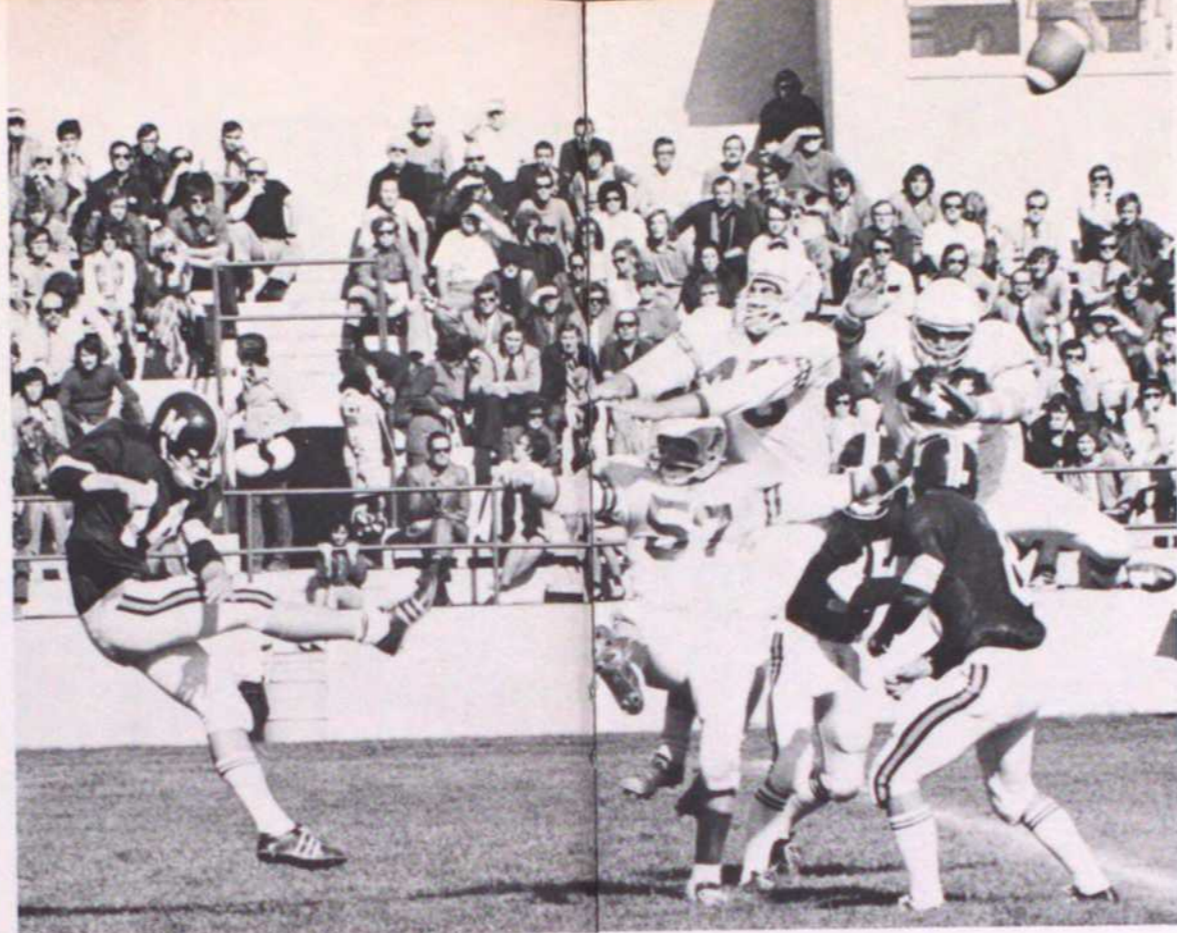
### COACHES' MESSAGE
