I hope that future years at Massey will be as good as this one just finished.

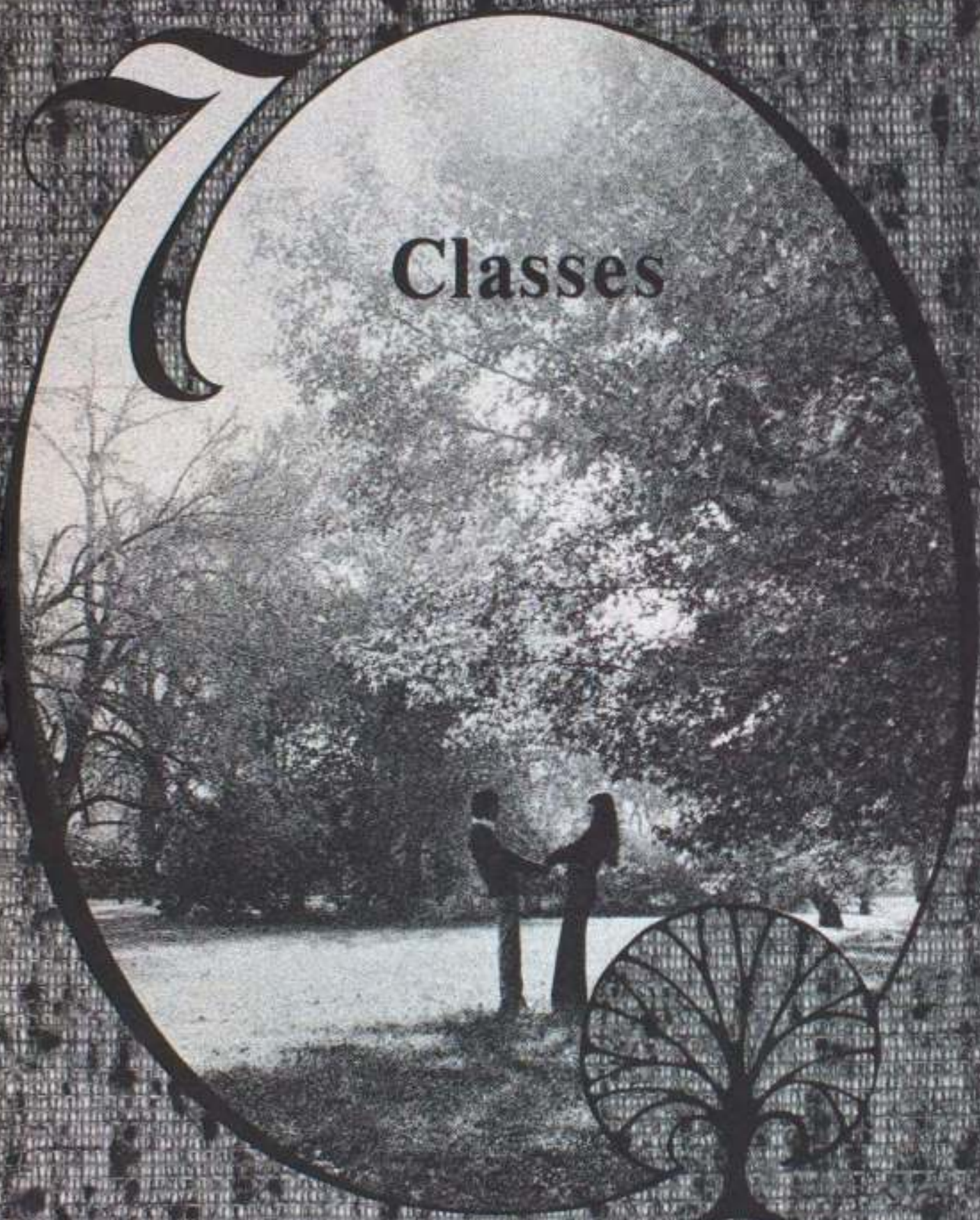
