

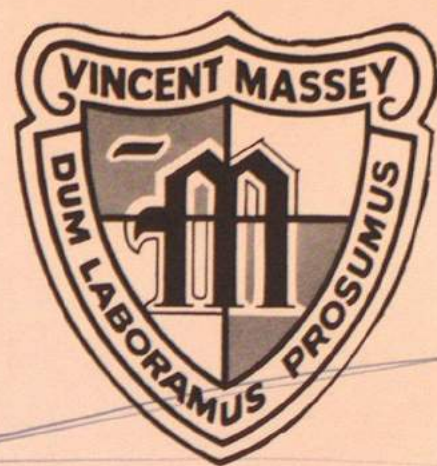

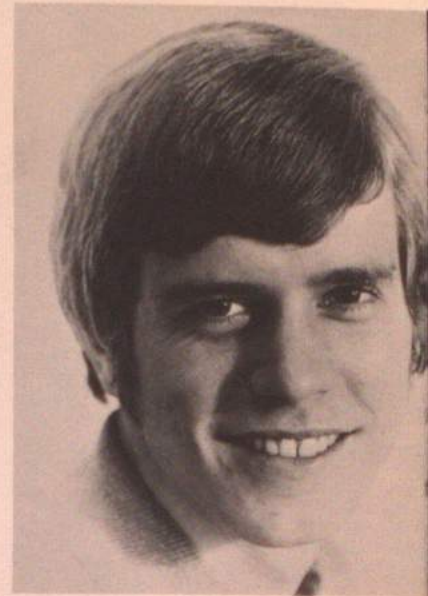

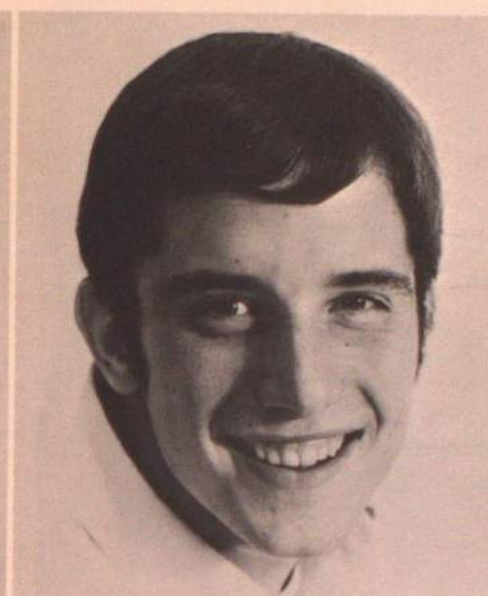

I would like to congratulate all the personnel in the school on the cheerful and enthusiastic manner in which co-operation was displayed throughout these difficult times.

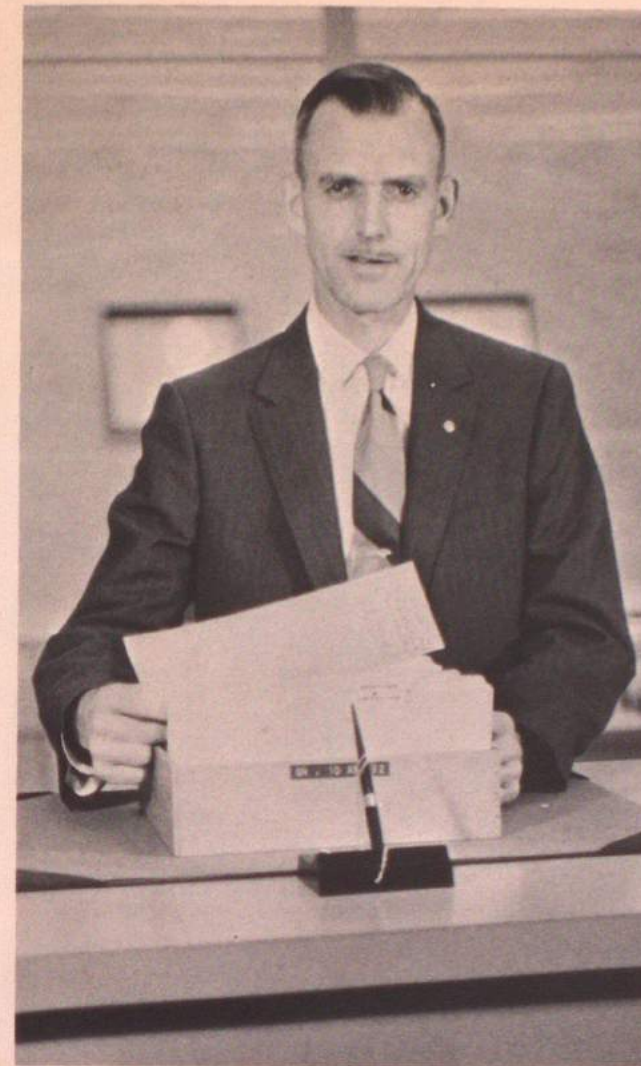
To the graduates: "Best of luck in your future endeavours."

To those students who remain behind: "Strive for success in your educational goals."

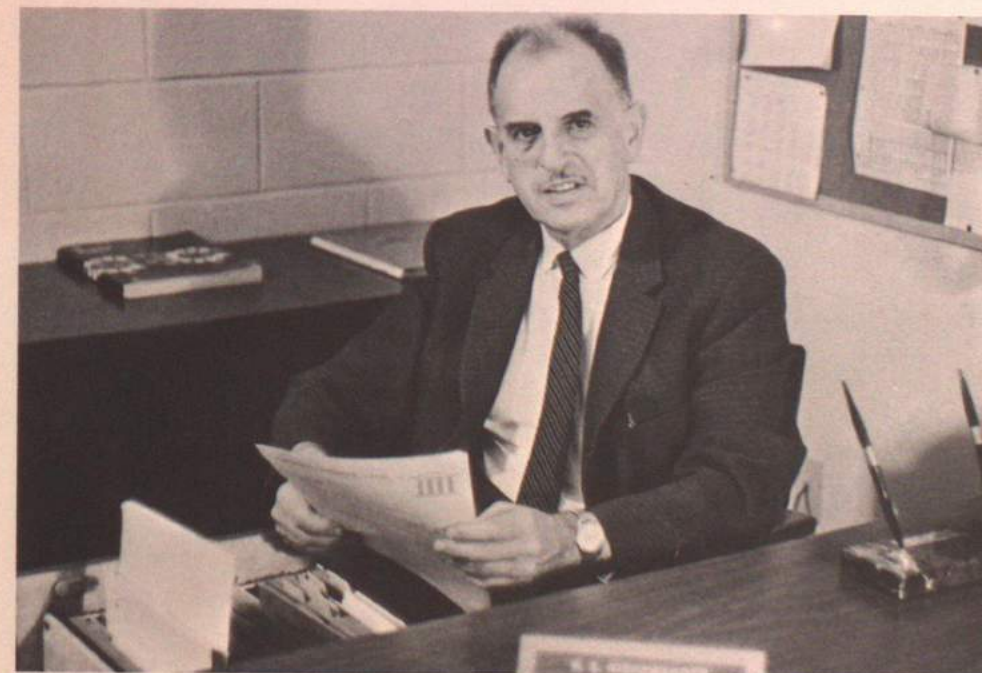
I wish also to give special thanks to the editor and the hard working staff of Pegasus '70 for such a fine production.

THE RED BALLOON MAN

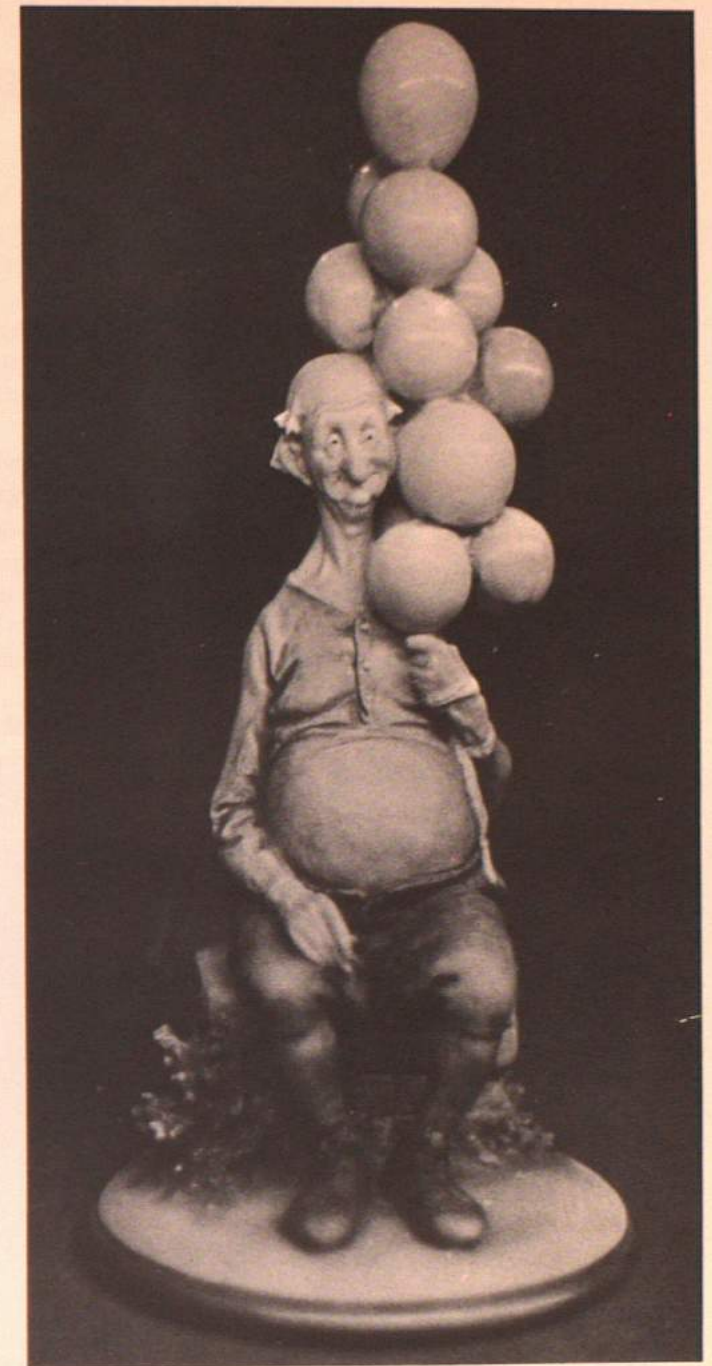
There's nothing in
