Cheering with Red Wing pride is Tony, Mary, Blaire, Jess, Ms. Brefka, and Chris.



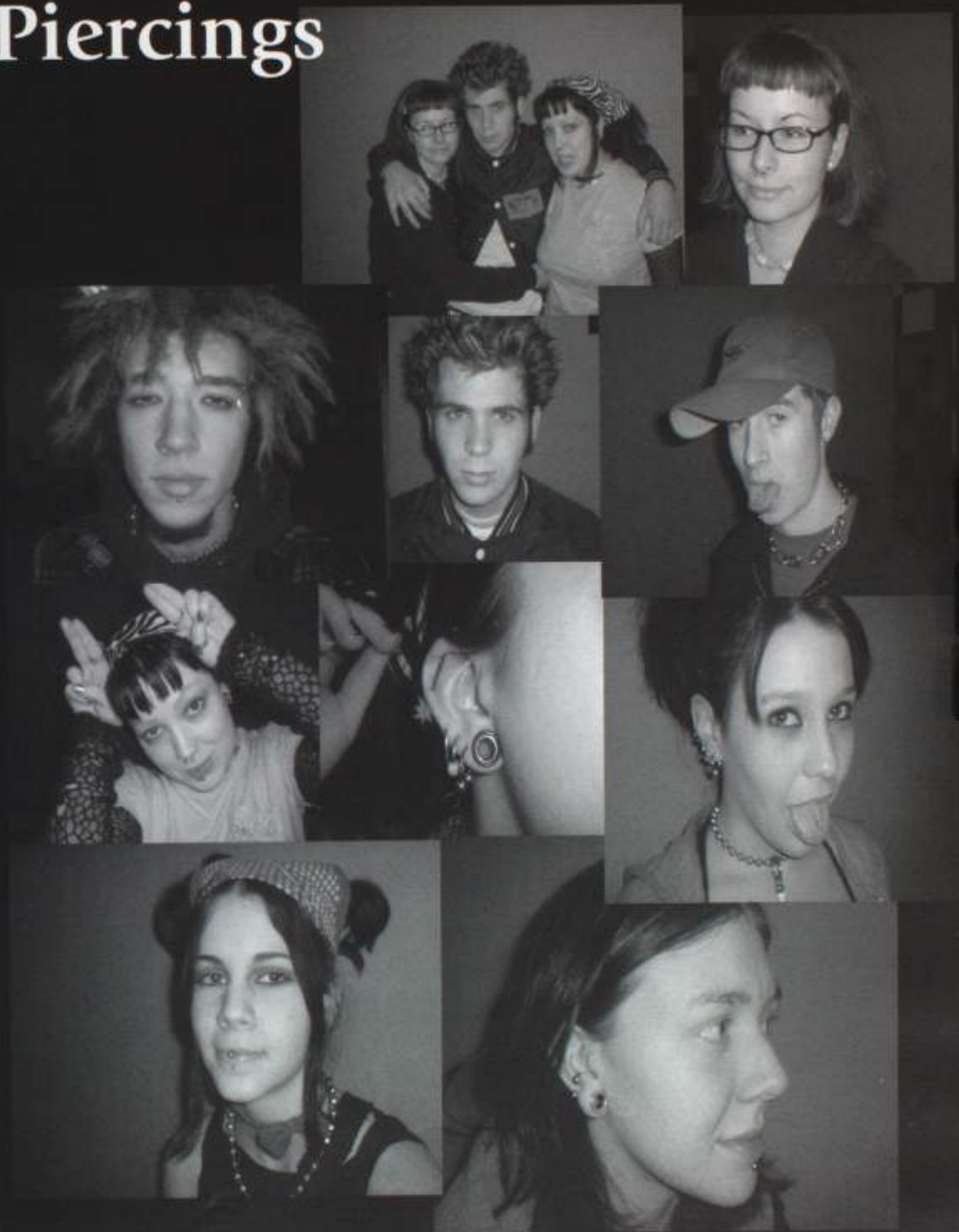

Math Contests

Pascal Mathematics Competition: The team made up of 100 grade 9's had 55 students in the top 25% in Canada. The team finished a respectable 20th in Canada, 7th in Ontario and 1st in Essex and Kent County. Eight students finished in the top ten in Essex-Kent. The team was made up of Jingjing Ma, Yin Hui and medalist Siyan Xing.



Canadian Open Mathematics Challenge: 31 of the 36 Massey competitors were among the top 25% in Canada with more than 5000 students. Several of our students had outstanding results. Hyon Lee tied with Rui Ma and Robert Biswas and Shaun White (69) 23rd in Canada- gold medal Ontario West. Zhongying Zhou (78)- 5th in Canada-gold medal Ontario West. Twelve Massey students qualified and wrote the Canadian Mathematics Olympiad with Jack Zhao obtaining our top score followed by Zhongying Zhou.



Fermat Mathematics Competition: The 78 students had 39 students in the top 25% in Canada and the team came 2nd in Canada, 2nd in Ontario, 2nd in Ontario West and 1st in Essex-Kent and Windsor. The team was made up of John Sun and Rui Ma and medalist Jack Zhao.



Cayley Mathematics Competition: The team made up of 85 students had 45 students in the top 25% in Canada while finishing 19th in Canada, 11th in Ontario West and first in Essex-Kent and Windsor. The team made up of Roman Shan, Roman Shapiro, and medalist Shaun White.



Fryer, Galois and Hypathia: this year three new contest were introduced and comprised of 4 full written solutions and extensions to these questions. Massey had 150 students take part. It appears that approximately 40 students were in the top 5% in Canada. Fan Feng, John Sun, Linda Wang and Zhiyuan "G" Wu all had perfect papers and Weibo Hao, Richard Ma, Jingjing Ma, and Siyuan Xing had 38 out of 40. Our top grade 10 was Taotao Liu who had 36 out of 40.



Canadian National Mathematics League: This year Massey had only 28/30 on the first contests we were perfect and ended up in first place in Canada for the first time and fifth in North America. Our team had many outstanding performances by the 70 students that regularly took part. Our leading students were Robert Biswas (4th in Canada) Yifei Wang who was 11th in Canada and John Sun who was 22nd in Canada.



American High School Mathematics Exam (AMC12 and AMC10): 230 math students at Massey wrote the AMC12 A and 65 wrote the AMC10 A and another 55 students wrote the AMC12 B during February. The results were astounding as 52 Massey students were above 100 on the AMC12 which qualified them to write the American Invitational exam. The team came first in Canada on the AMC12 A with 413 second and second in Canada on the AMC12 B with 422.5. Robert Biswas was 3rd in Canada and Zhongying Zhou was 7th in Canada. On the AIME Taotao Liu, John Sun and Hyon Lee scored 9 out of 15 on this Olympic selection exam. Yang Xia and Yiei Wang scored 8. There were 15 Massey competitors on the top 41 in Ontario.



Euclid Mathematics Competition: 150 students took part in the two and one half hour scholarship examination, and although all the results are not yet in, it appears we may have more than 80 students in the top 25% in Canada. The team was 1st in Canada, 1st in Ontario, 1st in Ontario West, Essex-Kent and Windsor. The team was Robert Biswas, Zhongying Zhou, and medalist Jack Zhao. Besides the three members of the team the following students ended in the top 36 in Canada. Yifei Wang, Linda Wang, John Sun, Taotao Liu, Valerie Cheung, and Fan Feng.



Outstanding Canadian Computer Contest Results

Again this year, Massey students excelled in the Canadian Computing Contest which is administered by the University of Waterloo. The contest requires students to solve five problems in three hours of computer time. We had over 40 students write the contest this year.

The top students in the senior contest were Yin (Jack) Zhao and Hyon Lee who were 11th and 19th in Canada respectively. Due to their outstanding results Jack and Hyon were invited to the second stage of the contest at the end of May. Unfortunately, a scheduling conflict prevents Hyon from attending so only Jack can attend (this is Jack's second year in a row). We wish him luck making the Canadian Computer team which will compete internationally later this year. Finishing in third place at Massey and 94th in Canada was Kelvin Xie.

In the junior contest, the top scorers were grade eleven students Rui Ma (4th), Frank Wang (7th), Paul Marchwica (19th) and John Sun (19th). In addition to these, outstanding results were turned in by the following grade ten students in their first year of programming: Weal Rammo (24th), Meng shan (33rd) and Andy Sun (37th). With so many strong juniors, the future looks bright for next year as well.

SCIENCE OLYMPIAD



Twelve students from Massey participated in the Great Lakes Science Olympiad on April 26th, 2003. The Olympiad is an all day event that includes all science and engineering strands. Twenty teams participated from Sarnia, Chatham, Essex county and Windsor regions.

Massey A team (composed of Sri Jamalapur, Robert Biswas, Valerie Chung, Hyon Lee, Xionying Zhao and Fan Feng) won the General knowledge event. They also won the computer science event where they had to write a computer robotics program. They came in 3rd place.

Massey B team (Michelle Sun, John Sun, Frank Wang, Laura Wang, Sicong Lee, and Amanda Naaum) won the engineering event where they had to suspend a penny in the air for as long as possible.

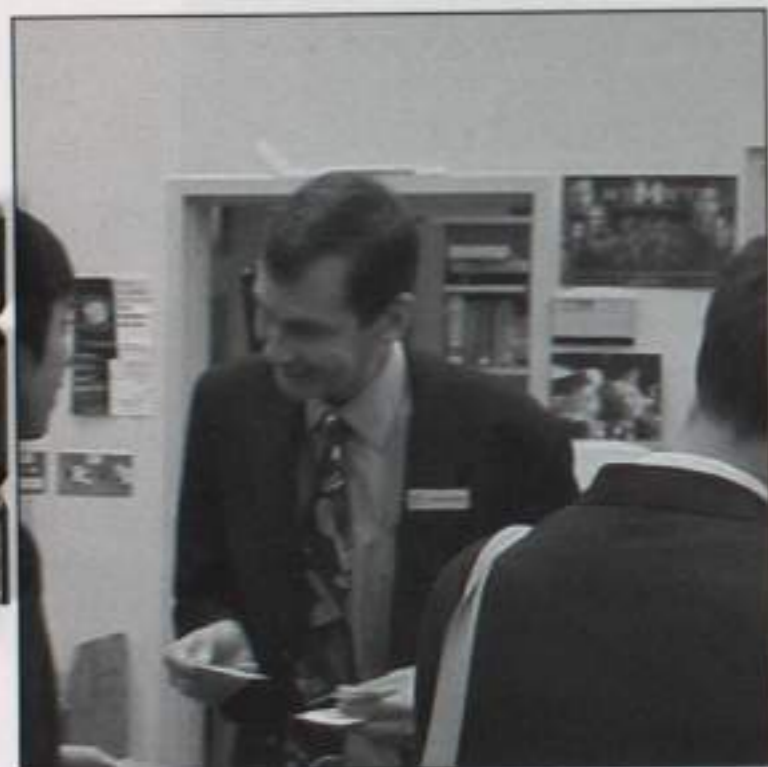

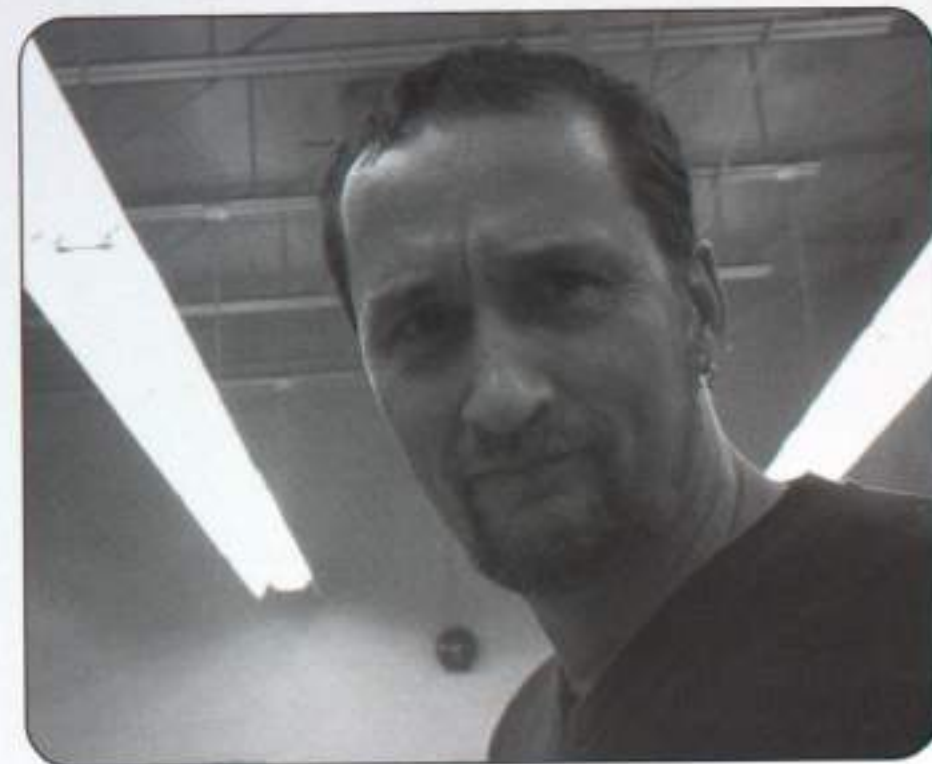
