# 2 + 2 = 4? MATH CONTESTS

This year has been a great year for Massey's mathematicians. 325 students from grade nine to twelve wrote 1342 math competitions during the year, as well as 180 minor competitions. 388 of our students achieved in the top 25% of all Canadian competitors - a record of any Windsor school. 35 Massey students were part of the Massey Ontario Team that competed at Penn State University with 120 teams from across North America and gained valuable experience for next year. Four students are among the 21 students invited to an Olympic Training camp, Siyuan Xing attended the National Olympic Camp for grade 9's and grade 10's. Four out of 65 students were invited to the University of Waterloo seminar from June 10<sup>th</sup> to June 16<sup>th</sup>. They were Taotao Liu, John Sun, Jimmy Shen and Shaun White.

**CANADIAN OPEN MATH CHALLENGE**  
This year was the either COMC, of the 42 students at Massey who wrote the Olympic exam election paper, 40 were above the average of 5100 of the best math students in Canada and there were many excellent scores. The top 25% of all those writing this special exam included 24 out of 42 Massey students. These 24 students were awarded certificates of distinction. Again this year, Massey dominated the results for Ontario West winning seven out of 12 gold medals that were awarded. The gold medalists are as follows: John Sun (third in Canada), Roman Shapiro (11<sup>th</sup> in Canada), Frank Wang (18<sup>th</sup> in Canada), Weibo Hao (27<sup>th</sup> in Canada), Yin Zhao (27<sup>th</sup> in Canada), Charley Jiang (49<sup>th</sup> in Canada) and Taotao Liu (64<sup>th</sup> in Canada).



**ARML**  
Early in the year, Massey competed in two ARML Power Questions competitions and finished third out of 50 teams across North America overall. In June, Massey took 35 students to compete in the American Regional Mathematics League held in Penn State University. In the team round, Massey finished third out of 100 teams, the team also finished ninth in the power question round. In the two relay rounds, we finished 12<sup>th</sup> and fifth respectively. John Sun and Shaun White tied for seventh out of 1600 students in the individual round and Jimmy Shen, Yang Xia, Siyuan Xing and Sean Cruise lead their teams.



**PASCAL**  
100 grade nine Massey students wrote the Pascal math contest. 85 of the grade nines were at or above the top 50% in Canada. 64 students were at or above the top 25% in Canada. The team was made up of Sean Cruise (first in SWOSSA; ninth in Ontario; 21<sup>st</sup> in Canada), Jesse Bauer (first in SWOSSA; ninth in Ontario; 21<sup>st</sup> in Canada) and Sean Yamana (third in SWOSSA; 37<sup>th</sup> in Ontario; 77<sup>th</sup> in Canada). The team came eighth out of 1598 teams in Canada, third out of 598 teams in Ontario, second out of 126 Ontario West, first out of 25 teams in SWOSSA, and first out of nine teams in WSSA.



**CAYLEY**  
105 grade 10 Massey students wrote the Cayley math contest, 85 of the grade being in the top 50% of 21553 competitors from the best math students in Canada. 51 students were at or above the top 25% in Canada. The team was made up of Siyuan Xing (first in SWOSSA; 13<sup>th</sup> in Ontario; 40<sup>th</sup> in Canada), Justin Liang (second in SWOSSA; 29<sup>th</sup> in Ontario; 78<sup>th</sup> in Canada) and Andy Kong (third in SWOSSA; 125<sup>th</sup> in Ontario). The team came in 22<sup>nd</sup> out of 1598 teams in Canada, 11<sup>th</sup> out of 598 teams in Ontario, second out of 124 teams in Ontario West, and for the thirteenth year in a row, first out of 25 teams in SWOSSA and first out of nine teams in WSSA.

**FERMAT**  
74 grade 11 Massey students wrote the Fermat math contest, 53 of the grade being at or above the Canadian average. We had two out of the total five perfect papers across Canada. The team was made up of Shaun White (first in SWOSSA; first in Ontario; first in Canada), Jimmy Shen (first in SWOSSA; first in Ontario; first in Canada) and Taotao Liu (third in SWOSSA; 20<sup>th</sup> in Ontario; 35<sup>th</sup> in Canada). The team came first out of 1332 teams in Canada, first out of 598 teams in Ontario, first out of 101 teams in Ontario West, first out of 30 teams in SWOSSA and first out of nine teams in WSSA.







**EUCLID**

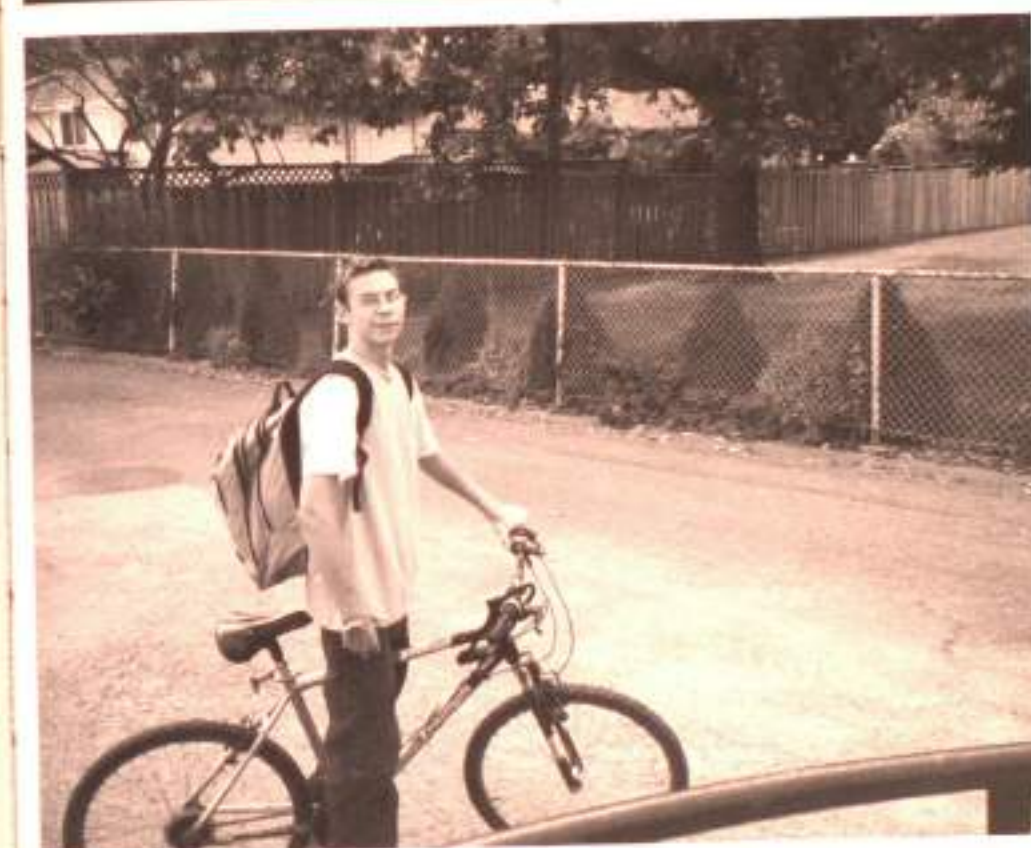

# St. Donat



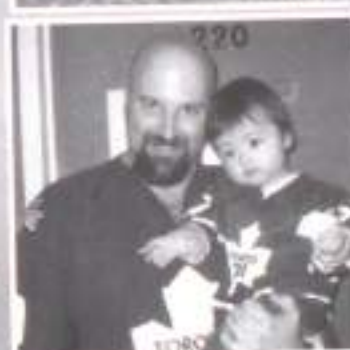

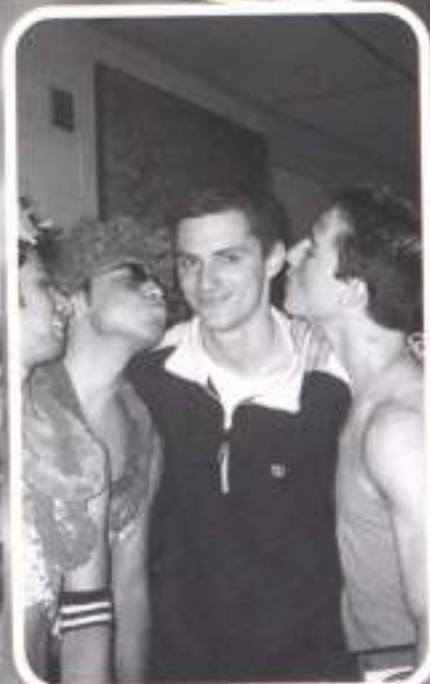
