GRADUATION

Valedictorian: the student usually having the highest rank in a graduating class, with the greatest overall average who excels in and outside of the classroom. Now, if that definition is true, I'm afraid you've all made a horrible decision, because I may be the wrong guy for the job. See, I'm not as smart as the Palmers, (two brains are always better than one). I'm not as good-looking as Scott Henry. I don't work as hard as Alice Snaden and I don't read or write as much as Kelsey Fischer. However, I didn't let that get to me. I took this speech very, very seriously. So, when I sat down to write it, about an hour ago, I thought to myself, how can I best describe our class of 2013 and the great experiences we have had at Walkerville? And I came to the conclusion, that I couldn't, at least not like this, not with your regular every day valedictorian speech that starts with "in the next chapter of our lives" or a quote by Ghandi, or references to world peace. That's got nothing to do with what we've accomplished. You see, I've always been more of a storyteller, and in honour of the unhealthy amount of movies I watch about super heroes and the end of the world, I decided to write "Valedictorious," the hero's story, a play, in 3 acts, covering the journey of high school from start to finish.
